**Re: Request for Relief to Facilitate Recovery Efforts During and Post COVID-19**


Reference is made to our video conference meeting on May 28, 2020 and your follow-up correspondence dated June 2, 2020, requesting an alternative to the Moratorium as a suitable source of relief to address the recovery efforts during the COVID-19 crisis.

Management has been closely monitoring the impact of COVID-19 on its business and its stakeholders. As a business partner, we have considered your request and would like to advise that the Saint Lucia Air and Sea Ports Authority (SLASPA) has agreed to the following:

1. Provide a two (2) months waiver on rental charges for office space at La Place Carenage (LPC) for the months of April and May 2020.
2. To provide a 40% discount for tenants and concessionaires at LPC for the months of June to September 2020.
3. Members that have an outstanding balance over 120 days as at March 31, 2020, will enter into a payment plan arrangement to regularize their accounts.

SLASPA will be exceedingly grateful if the Saint Lucia Hospitality & Tourism Association would communicate this information to its members.
